**Re: 2026 COA Post-Secondary Education Bursary Program**

Applications are now being accepted for the **COA Post-Secondary Education Bursary Program**. The COA provides a **\$500 bursary** for dependent children who are enrolled in a recognized post-secondary education program.

As approved by the membership at the **2025 AGM**, bursary eligibility has been expanded as follows:

- **Students enrolled in a two-year college program** may apply in each year of their program, to a maximum of **\$1,000** (\$500 per year).
- **Students enrolled in a university program** may apply for each year of their studies, to a maximum of **\$2,000** (\$500 per year for up to four years).

**Applications will be accepted until July 31, 2026.** Eligible members are encouraged to submit their applications before the deadline.

To ensure applications can be processed efficiently, please note the following requirements:

- Applications must be submitted using the **attached COA Bursary Application Form**.
- Applications must be submitted **electronically** to [mmaville@oppcoa.ca](mailto:mmaville@oppcoa.ca).
- Please do not send applications or supporting documents to [treasurer@oppcoa.on.ca](mailto:treasurer@oppcoa.on.ca), as that email account has been deactivated.
- **Confirmation of enrolment** from the educational institution is required.
- Please ensure your **current mailing address** is included on the application, as bursary cheques will be distributed via **Canada Post**.
- To facilitate processing, **please do not submit photographs** of the application form or confirmation of enrolment documents. Electronic copies (PDF format preferred) should be provided.

If you have any questions regarding eligibility or the application process, please contact the COA Executive.
